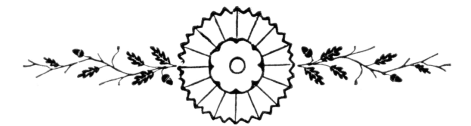

Super Bowls and Prostitutes

Eugene Robinson seemed to be the perfect man. He was well educated. He was athletic. He was wealthy. He was a professing Christian. And in 1999, he was playing in the Super Bowl.

On the Saturday before the Super Bowl, Robinson had been awarded the Athletes in Action Outstanding Citizenship Award for demonstrating the godliest character on the field that year. Yes, he was competitive. But he was a good man, a man of Christian virtues. That Saturday, Robinson gave scores of interviews, during which he publicly witnessed to his relationship with Jesus.

But later that night, Robinson was the one asking the questions. Unbeknownst to him, he asked an undercover police officer for sex, thinking she was a prostitute. Suddenly, this all-star Christian role model was in handcuffs and confined to a Miami jail cell for soliciting prostitution. You can imagine the scandal that broke loose the next day. His wife was called. His coaches were called. The reporters who had been interviewing him the day before now had a sensational piece of information with which to end their articles on him. The model of godly manhood that Eugene Robinson had built suddenly collapsed on the eve of Super Bowl 31.

How do you recover from a moral failure like that? How do you rebuild your life, your reputation, and your relationships? And where is God when you blow it so big? Does God abandon us in moments like these? If not, how do you find Him, how do you meet Him, in such crises? Robinson eventually recovered, and his second career has taken off. But what about you? Have you had colossal failures that you didn't know how to recover from? Have you wondered where God can be found in moments like those? We'll find out today.
