When What's Wrong Is Who You Are

No one likes to be defined by terms that they don't get to pick. For instance, if someone were to define me, I would hope to be able to supply most of that definition myself. Unfortunately, this isn't how most of the definitions that get attached to us work. Sometimes, we get defined by our character traits: "She's that nice lady who always helps people...He's the guy with the bad temper..." Sometimes, we get defined by our quirks, which my favorite show of all time, *Seinfeld*, was famous for: "He's a 'close-talker'... She had 'man-hands!'... They call him the 'Soup Nazi'."

In the story we're looking at today, a woman isn't given a name. She's given a description, a description that defines her life. She had a debilitating affliction for twelve years and couldn't get effective treatment. In fact, the treatments had only increased her suffering. This disease had become all-consuming for her, touching and ruining almost every part of her life. For her, what was wrong had become who she was.

But the beautiful thing about Jesus is that he doesn't allow what's wrong in our lives to ultimately define us. If we come to him, he'll give us a new definition, something joyous and life-giving by which to be known. For the woman, her sickness shut her out from both social and religious interactions. She was unclean. But Jesus purifies her, heals her, and blesses her with peace. In this case, we still don't know her name. But we know that she's no longer defined by what's wrong with her. Instead, she's defined by what Jesus has done for her. She's given healing and peace, a healing and peace that puts her life back where it belonged. In this new series, we're talking about the peace that Jesus gives and what it does. I think you'll be blessed by it. *Matt Carver*
