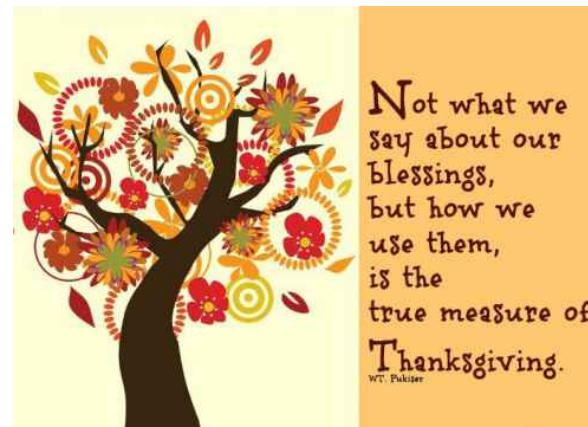

Ambrose, a fourth century bishop, once noted about Christ's peace: "It is the part of those who have been perfected not to be easily influenced by worldly things or to be troubled with fear or tormented with suspicion or stunned with dread or distressed with pain. Rather, as if on a shore of total safety, they ought to calm their spirit, immovable as it is in the anchorage of faith against the rising waves and tempests of the world. Christ brought this support to the spirits of Christians when He brought an inner peace to the souls of those who had proved themselves, so that our heart should not be troubled or our spirit be distressed. ... The fruit of peace is the absence of disturbance in the heart."

The fears and anxieties that so easily beset modern Christians can make Ambrose's remark seem shallow and naïve. Do we not frequently feel "disturbance[s] in the heart," easily influenced by "worldly things ... troubled with fear ... or distressed with pain?" Of course we are. How, then, can we be expected to live as if our homes are planted on shores of total safety?

The answer of Scripture is the peace of Christ. In our texts today, Jesus assuages the creeping anxiety of the apostles with an assurance of "my peace" (John 14:27). Olivier Clement, writing from France in 1991, remarked, "In the New Testament, the 'peace of Christ' is a synonym for that life stronger than death which is brought to us by the Resurrection." We can't dissect how this peace operates in the heart, but we can trust it, dwell on it, and believe that Jesus gives us peace to put us back where we belong. We'll look further into how He does this today.
