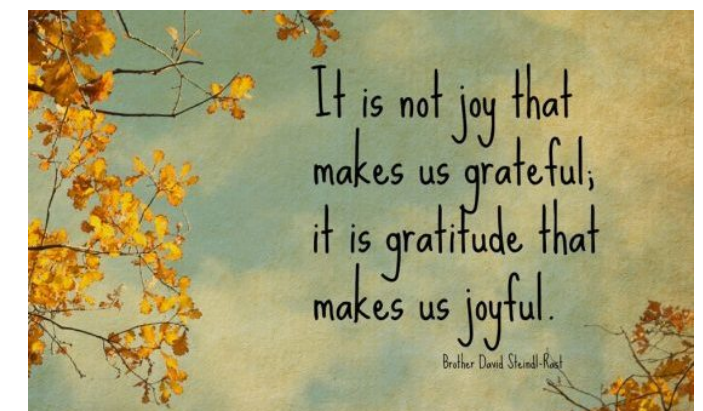


IGNITE will meet from **5:00 to 7:00** tonight at Eastside. Dinner will be furnished.

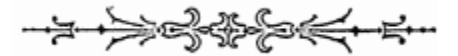

It's Good to Be Naked (Sort of)

When people abandon the proper roles between themselves and God, bad things happen. Desires and goals become corrupt and twisted. And, when two married people abandon the proper roles between their marriage and God, bad things happen, too.

When the first human pair, Adam and Eve, did this, we're told that their own relationship would suffer. Speaking to the woman, God said, "Your desire shall be toward your husband, but he shall rule over you" (Gen 3:16). Scholars have found this verse notoriously difficult to both translate and interpret, but its essence can be described like this: When married people abandon the proper roles between their relationship and God, a woman will bring her desires, ambitions, and vulnerabilities to her man and he will exploit and misuse them for his own gain. It doesn't take much reflection to realize just how true to life this can be.

But this wasn't the original ideal for marriage. The original ideal was pictured like this: "And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed" (Gen 2:25). That may sound like an odd way to describe an ideal marriage, but that was the biblical portrait of a perfectly ordered marriage in God's paradise. Marriage, as God designed it, was two people, standing before God and each other, with nothing to hide, nothing to protect, and nothing to be ashamed about. In God's ideal for marriage, it was good to be naked.

But not so much anymore. As earlier mentioned, the original human pair broke that ordered pattern and the relationship fractured. Suddenly, shame washed over each partner as they became aware of their own evil and the increased potential for evil in the other. Can this breach be repaired? The Bible says "Yes," and today Paul and Moses are going to show us how in what we're calling a Spirit-filled marriage.
