**The Large Dangerousness of Life**  
 H.G. Wells, the famous novelist of the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, was reportedly on an ocean liner one foggy morning when suddenly, out of the haze, there emerged another ship. As the captains made their evasive maneuvers, the two ships glided past each other with only yards to spare. On that day, Wells said he came face to face with what he called the "general large dangerousness of life."

Most of us will admit that there is a "large dangerousness" to life. What starts as just another Sunday morning can end in tragedy and horror. There are threats to life and happiness all around us, and the delicate edge upon which we all balance our lives can be quickly jostled and undone. Little wonder that we all so desperately crave peace, tranquility and an end to danger, fear, and worry.

Today, we're closing our series on the peace of Christ by looking once more at Paul's writings. Paul has a "thick" view of Christ's peace, seeing it as reconciliation with God as the fulfillment of numerous Jewish hopes and seeing it also as an internal power that creates new possibilities for our lives and relationships. But we all have an arch-nemesis who opposes this peace. It is Satan. Satan is the robber of our peace, and he pursues his spiritual thievery through so many channels as to frequently leave us tricked and bewildered. It's hard to predict the source of his assaults, but we can usually recognize them once the attack begins. With today's message, we'll look at how the peace of Jesus puts us back where we belong in our fight with our most ancient foe.
