**No Jiggery-Pokery**

In 1930, a group of London-based writers came together to form what they called the Detection Club. This was at the height of the murder-mystery genre's popularity. Everyone read murder-mysteries, and the challenge was to continue to produce high-quality "who dun it" stories. The Detection Club was comprised of noteworthy authors such as Dorothy Sayers, Agatha Christie, and G.K. Chesterton. They gathered periodically to critique each other's work, to trade writer's tips, and to hold dinner parties. They even developed an oath that they all had to take about the literature they were trying to produce. Part of this oath was as follows:

"Do you promise that your detectives shall well and truly detect the crimes presented to them using those wits which it may please you to bestow upon them and not placing reliance on nor making use of Divine Revelation, Feminine Intuition, Mumbo Jumbo, Jiggery-Pokery, Coincidence, or Act of God?"

What was this all about? Simply put, they didn't want each other's detectives to cheat. They demanded that their detective characters actually detect. They must analyze facts and dig deep using their own powers of observation and puzzle-solving. They must use truth to uncover more truth until finally they arrive at the truth of who committed the murder or perpetuated the crime. No "Jiggery-Pokery" allowed.

Truth matters, and the pursuit of truth is honorable. This was what the Detection Club understood and enshrined in their oath. Unfortunately, this belief has waned. We live in the age of "truthiness" where facts are exchanged for hunches, emotionalism, and tribalism. But the Christian faith gives us a vision of how to think, how to behave, and how to sort through the maze of information overload we experience today. It teaches us how to be discerning communities who think like Jesus and make decisions with God at the center. That's what this new series is about: Discernment. And there'll be no Jiggery-Pokery allowed.
