New Testament scholar William Barclay once observed, "This world is full of things which are sordid and shabby and soiled and smutty." I don't think we question that this observation is true, but we should question our ability to stay away from all those things. What kind of music do you listen to? What are your favorite shows on Netflix? What kind of stories do you read the most? I'm not saying that everyone should listen to nothing but *Gaither Homecoming* CD's, but I am suggesting that we probably don't hold ourselves accountable for what we allow into our heart as much as we should. And no sooner would we disavow the sordid, shabby, soiled, and smutty things of our world than we turn around and digest exactly those things through the media we consume.

Can we keep ourselves from shabby and smutty things? And should we? I think total avoidance is unrealistic, and Paul would agree. To Corinth, he wrote, "I wrote to you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people—not at all meaning the sexually immoral of this world, or the greedy and swindlers, or idolaters, since then you would need to go out of the world" (1 Cor. 5:9-10). In other words, you can and should avoid associations with impure persons (he goes on to identify these impure persons as professing Christians!), but you can't possibly avoid associations with every impure person in the world. Doubtlessly he would say the same about "things" and ideas, too. We can and should avoid some, but we cannot possibly avoid all.
