Trained for Ugliness

Watch the news, read the headlines, or scroll through your social media and you'll find a world that is impure, vicious, blameworthy, and unjust. You'll be reminded daily that you live in an ugly place, full of ugly people who do ugly things. You'll be bombarded with the ugliness of a world gone mad.

That's partly true, of course. There's lots of ugliness in our world. But news reporters and social media content creators know that this is exactly what so many of us respond to. Reporting the ugly is what makes us click that link, play that podcast, or find that channel. And it's been this way for most of our lifetimes. We've been conditioned to respond to ugliness with absorbing interest because in some sordid way the ugly titillates us. It carries the thrill of shock and sensationalism, so we tune in. We can't seem to help ourselves. Like the proverbial car wreck, we can't seem to look away from the nasty and horrific. We've been trained for ugliness.

But are these aspects the best, most interesting, most worthy parts of God's world? The Bible tells us that God made the world to be good and beautiful, and much of that goodness and beauty remain, even if harder to find. The good Creator has made good things, and He wants us to find them and enjoy them. And according to Paul, He wants us to marinate our minds in them. He wants us to think on "whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable." He wants us to do this so that we "un-train" ourselves to prefer the ugly things and condition ourselves for loveliness. In doing this, he knows that we'll then become the kind of people who can discern the lovely, commendable, beautiful things out of all that ugliness out there. This is the discernment that we're talking about today.
