"She Had Dirty Elbows"

Back in 1995, New York Times columnist John Tierney wrote a humorous article entitled, "The Big City: Picky, Picky, Picky." He was describing the odd phenomenon of widespread loneliness in a city brimming with people. He frames his report by asking a hypothetical question that the average New Yorker might ask themselves at the end of another Valentine's Day: "Why am I going home alone?" The answer, Tierney proposes, is the in-built "Flaw-O-Matic" that modern men and women carry around with them all the time. The Flaw-O-Matic is "an inner voice, a little whirring device inside the brain, that instantly spots a fatal flaw in any potential mate." Evidence of this mental device was all around Tierney. On one fateful evening, he was watching the television show, "The Love Connection," when one young man described to the host why his latest romance didn't work out: "Well, it started out great," the young man said. "She opened the door and she looked fantastic—beautiful face, great body, nice smile. Everything was going fine—until she turned around." He paused dramatically and shook his head. "Chuck," he said sorrowfully. "She had dirty elbows." And that was when he knew the relationship was doomed.

Finding the right lifetime partner is hard, and sustaining that relationship is even harder. Jesus, however, gives us abundant spiritual resources to create and sustain a lasting and vibrant relationship with our mates. Unfortunately, we seldom use it. One of the greatest resources, and perhaps one of the most overlooked, is the Holy Spirit. Jesus, in giving us the Holy Spirit, equips us for beautiful, strong marriages that endure the trials of time.
