You can fill in the blank to that line. It's an old children's song that usually gets revived around VBS and camp times. Father Abraham had many sons, but who are they? And what are they supposed to be? Abraham was a crucial figure in the history of the Jews. He was, quite literally, their father. And as it went with ancestors in the ancient Near East, it was expected that a man's descendants would be very much like him. Indeed, the Bible makes frequent use of this paradigm—of the descendants reflecting their forefathers' qualities—when it describes Esau and the Edomites, or Lot's grandsons, named Moab and Ben-ammi, who became the progenitors for the Moabite and Ammonite peoples.
