Winning When You're Not Good at Winning

I used to be good at winning. I loved baseball, and I could hit at least one homerun in almost every game. When I became a pitcher, I struck out batters by the handfuls. My teams didn't always win the championship, but we were always contenders (and we did win one championship). Yep, Little League was the best.

But as I got older, my athletic ability sort of leveled out. And honestly, my interest in getting any better was low. After freshman year of high school, I got my driver's license and suddenly found that I had better things to do than run laps, sweat under a scorching sun, and get yelled at for missing jump shots and ground balls. Thus, my athletic career came to an end at age 16. But I was still interested in winning. In fact, lots of people are still interested in winning, regardless of their age. Granted, for me, winning is sometimes ill-defined. It's not as clear-cut as scoring more points than the other team and watching them walk off the field or court with their heads hung low. In my adult years, winning can sometimes look like not cracking under the pressures of life, not yelling at my kids when they've made the same mistake five times, and continuing to help people through problems that they've mostly brought on themselves.

Our sermon series explores the spiritual lives of the Jewish fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Today, we're walking along with Isaac as he travels from place to place, digging new wells and re-digging old ones because other people were basically bullying him. Whether Isaac was just peaceable or a chump, it doesn't look like he wins much against other people. But there's a spiritual side to Isaac's apparent "losses," and it holds promise for our own journey with God. Let's have a look together.
